There are **5 Principles of Inclusive Governance**.

These principles guide the way organisations work.



1. We include people with intellectual disability when we are making decisions. We value this inclusion.



2. We make it easy for people with intellectual disability to get involved in our organisation.



3. We make our Board meetings and activities easier for people with intellectual disability to take part.



4. We provide the support that people need.



5. We do whatever is needed to make Inclusive Governance work.
